This South Crew job was located in Colorado Springs and **Ryan Drawe** was the Superintendent. **Udo Hughes** was our

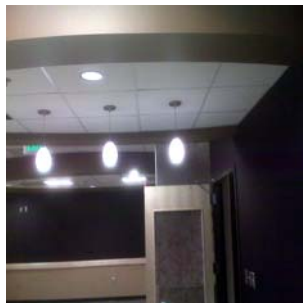

installation of the canopies. A total of eighteen Armstrong SoundScape Canopies were put in above existing desks and workstations to

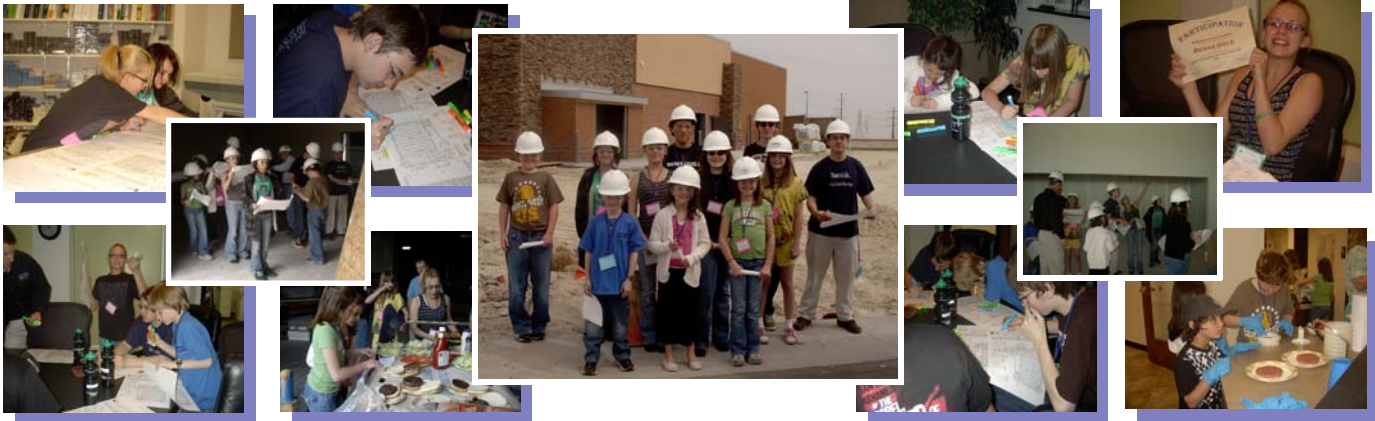


provide acoustical sound control in an exposed structure space.
