Key Bank - Bronco's Parkway

The Key Bank at Broncos Parkway was one of two Key Bank stores we did with **Waner Construction** this summer.



The Heartland team for this project was **Dan Vandenburg** as Estimator and Project Manager with **Ryan Drawe** as our Superintendent.

This store was a typical Key Bank layout that included 3,800 square feet of Armstrong Suprafine

9/16" grid with Armstrong Dune tegular-edge acoustical ceiling tile. The bank is comprised of

a large customer area with a high ceiling and it is connected to a lower teller area. There are also private offices and other non-customer areas that have suspended acoustical ceilings.

The project included over 3,700 square feet of Armstrong Superfine 9/16" ceiling grid with Armstrong Dune tegular-edge acoustical ceiling tile, numerous Armstrong SoundScape circle acoustical clouds, a large amount of Tectum acoustical panels applied to the bottom of the roof structure plus a lot of Armstrong Axiom perimeter trims.
